

**CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2018-13**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING  
CHAPTER 74 OF THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES BY  
CREATING SCHEDULE II THEREIN IN ORDER TO PROHIBIT  
CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC, TRUCKS AND EQUIPMENT FROM USING  
OR TRAVELING UPON CHURCH, SCOTT AND HIGH STREETS,  
SHOWALTER TRACE, AND JONES ROAD.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Walton, Kentucky, by and through previous City Councils, Mayors and Administrations, has annexed and zoned real estate for The Walton Kentucky Industrial Park development;

**WHEREAS**, certain restrictions and conditions were imposed upon the development, which were agreed to buy the developer, and which required the developer to build a new roadway to be constructed from Mary Grubbs Highway Extension into the site that would prevent any traffic related to the development from traveling on residential streets, all before construction of the industrial park;

**WHEREAS**, the industrial park has been under construction for months and the new roadway is not complete, resulting in the closure of Mary Grubbs Highway Extension, the routing of heavy trucks, equipment and construction traffic through residential areas, particularly via Church, Scott and High Streets, Showalter Trace, and Jones Road;

**WHEREAS**, this construction related traffic on residential streets is dangerous to the residents and visitors in the area, poses a safety threat, causes hardships and inconveniences, and is causing damage to the roadways and abutting properties.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION ONE**

Chapter 74 of the City of Walton Code Of Ordinances is hereby amended by creating SCHEDULE II therein as follows:

**SCHEDULE II: PROHIBITED CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC**

(A) Construction vehicles, trucks and equipment are prohibited from using or otherwise traveling upon the following:

Church Street – from Dixie Highway to Showalter Trace;

Scott Street – entire length;

High Street - entire length;

Showalter Trace - entire length;

Jones Road – from High Street west and south to the Walton City Limits.

(B) Excluded from the prohibition in Section (A), above, are construction vehicles, trucks and equipment which are servicing or delivering to homes on the referenced roadways, vehicles and equipment owned by the residents of the referenced roadways, and any garbage trucks, school busses and other vehicles that require access to those homes on a day to day basis.

(C) Any person, firm, corporation or company who violates any prohibition in this Schedule II for which another penalty is not specifically provided shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500) for each offense.

## **SECTION TWO**

This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force upon its enactment and publication as required by law.

## **SECTION THREE**

All ordinances or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of the conflict, if any, are hereby repealed.

## **SECTION FOUR**

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular situation is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

## **SECTION FIVE**

This ordinance may be read and published in summary form.
