

**CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 2019-06**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, REPEALING ORDINANCE 2017-20, THEREBY RESCINDING THE REQUIREMENT TO INSTALL STOP SIGNS ON OLD STEPHENSON MILL ROAD AT THE INTERSECTION WITH CENTRAL AVENUE AND ITS PROVISION IMPLEMENTING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; THEREBY REQUIRING THE ELIMINATION AND REMOVAL OF THE STOP SIGNS ON OLD STEPHENSON MILL ROAD AT THE INTERSECTION WITH CENTRAL AVENUE, AND THE STOP SIGN ON CENTRAL AT STEPHENSON MILL TO REMAIN.

WHEREAS, by adoption of Ordinance 2017-20 on February 13, 2018, the City of Walton, Kentucky required that stop signs shall be installed in both directions on Old Stephenson Mill Road at the intersection with Central Avenue to form an all-way stop; and that a violation of that Ordinance shall be punishable upon conviction in a court of competent jurisdiction by a fine of not less than twenty dollars (\$20.00) and not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in accordance with KRS 189.990(1); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Walton, Kentucky now believes that the public safety, health and welfare of the City, its citizens and its visitors, would be better served without the presence of the stop signs on Stephenson Mill at that intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

Ordinance 2017-20 of the City of Walton, Kentucky, is hereby repealed in its entirety, including without limitation its requirement that stop signs shall be installed in both directions on Old Stephenson Mill Road at the intersection with Central Avenue to form an all-way stop, and its provision implementing penalties for violations thereof.

SECTION TWO

Upon adoption and publication of this Ordinance, both stop signs on Old Stephenson Mill Road at the intersection with Central Avenue shall be eliminated and removed. This Ordinance shall have no effect on the stop sign on Central at Stephenson Mill, which shall remain.

SECTION THREE

This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force after its enactment and publication as required by law.

SECTION FOUR

All ordinances or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of the conflict, if any, are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular situation is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

SECTION SIX

This ordinance may be read and published in summary form.
