

**CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 2018- 02**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN ORDER TO CLASSIFY VIOLATIONS OF THE CITY'S PARKING ORDINANCES AS CIVIL OFFENSES WITH CIVIL FINES, THEREBY SUBJECTING SUCH VIOLATIONS TO THE CITY'S CODE ENFORCEMENT ORDINANCES PROCEDURES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Walton, Kentucky, has previously adopted Code Enforcement Ordinances, codified as Sections 34.40 thru 34.77 of the City of Walton Code of Ordinances, and now has determined that there is a need to classify violations of the City's Parking Ordinances which are codified in Chapters 72 and 75 of the City of Walton Code of Ordinances, as civil offenses with civil fines, and to subject such violations to the procedures set forth in the Code Enforcement Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

Chapter 72 of the City of Walton Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended by creating new Section 72.99 therein, as follows:

§ 72.99 PARKING VIOLATIONS CLASSIFIED AS CIVIL OFFENSES WITH CIVIL FINES FOR VIOLATIONS.

- A. Any violation of a provision contained in Chapters 72 or 75 of this Code of Ordinances is hereby classified as a civil offense, pursuant to KRS 65.8808 and §§ 34.40 thru 34.77 of this Code of Ordinances, and such classification is intended, and shall be construed, to provide an additional or supplemental means of obtaining compliance with these provisions, and nothing contained herein shall prohibit the enforcement of these provisions by any other means authorized by law.
- B. Civil Fines for violations of Chapters 72 and 75 of this Code of Ordinances shall be as set forth in §§ 34.51 and 34.74 of this Code of Ordinances and amendments thereto.
- C. Each abovementioned provision of Chapters 72 and 75 violated shall be considered a separate fineable offense. If two (2) or more abovementioned provisions of Chapters 72 or 75 are violated, the fines shall be cumulative and may be enforced under the same Citation. Each day a violation exists shall be considered a separate offense without issuance of a separate Citation.

SECTION TWO

This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force after its enactment and publication as required by law.

SECTION THREE

All ordinances or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of the conflict, if any, are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular situation is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

SECTION FIVE

This ordinance may be read and published in summary form.
