

**CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 2018-03**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN ORDER TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OR PLACEMENT OF ANY PORTABLE STORAGE UNIT, PORTABLE MOVING CONTAINER, OR SIMILAR, AT ANY TIME, IN OR ON ANY PUBLIC WAY, STREET, SIDEWALK OR ROAD IN THE CITY OF WALTON.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Walton, Kentucky, has determined that there is a need to prohibit the parking or placement of any portable storage unit, portable moving container, or similar, at any time, in or on any public way, street, sidewalk or road in the City of Walton in order to protect the health, safety and Welfare of the citizens and visitors of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

Chapter 72 of the City of Walton Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended by creating new Section 72.07 therein, as follows:

§ 72.07 PARKING OF PORTABLE STORAGE/MOVING UNITS/CONTAINERS PROHIBITED.

No person shall park, place or leave standing any portable storage unit or portable moving container, or similar, at any time, in or on any public way, street, sidewalk or road in the City of Walton.

SECTION TWO

This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force after its enactment and publication as required by law.

SECTION THREE

All ordinances or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of the conflict, if any, are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular situation is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any

other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

SECTION FIVE

This ordinance may be read and published in summary form.
