Council Member John Wainwright moved to approve **Ordinance No. 2019-01** on its second reading adopting the city’s stormwater quality management ordinance in order to prohibit illicit discharges and illicit connections to the city’s stormwater system in furtherance of the city’s continuing efforts to keep the city’s storm water management practices in compliance with state and federal law. **Ordinance No. 2019-02** was also approved on its second reading adopting the city’s post-construction stormwater management in new development and redevelopment ordinance in order to establish minimum requirements and procedures to control the adverse effects of increased post-construction stormwater runoff and non-point source pollution associated with new development and redevelopment in furtherance of the city’s continuing efforts to keep the city’s stormwater management practices in compliance with state and federal law. Council Member Rose Beach seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following Council Members voted “yes”: Barb Farrow, John Wainwright, Bobby McDonald, Rose Beach, Stephanie Williams, and Matt Brown.
