Items Discussed

Matt Bogen discussed the High Street bridge construction agreement; it just needs to be signed and scanned and an original copy will need to be kept at City Hall. Sewer projects – Monarch Engineering Aosta Valley upgrade the Mayor signed easements on April 5, 2021. The sewer is at seventy percent max capacity, the sewer plant is going to need to be upgraded. Owens Property- The main focus should be looking at the house, some dense grading getting to the house. Fish and Wild Life are coming out to give us a depth map. The Walton Fire Department has volunteered to suck out water with a hose and by doing so this will save the city money on our drudging cost. The tennis courts at the main city park need to be repaired this year, we will spend money from the splash pad on repairing the tennis courts. We will get this ready to go out to bid A.S.A.P.

Budget prep will begin in May and the hope will be to have a first reading in May and a second reading in June. We will start planning for Old Fashion Day on May 11, prior to council meeting at 6:15 p.m., this year the event falls on the 20th anniversary for 9/11.
