**Approval of Agenda**

1. **ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01** AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING ORDINANCES 2018-15, 2022-05, AND SECTION 31.03 OF THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES IN ORDER TO REVISE THE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE TIMING OF PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL. Council member Matt Brown motioned to approve Ordinance 2023-01. Amy Long seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following council members voted “yes”: Rose Beach, Matt Brown, Terri Courtney, Amy Long, Dan Martin and Sherry Snowden.
  
2. **ORDINANCE NO. 2023-02** AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING CHAPTER 74 OF THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED *TRAFFIC SCHEDULES*, BY CREATING SCHEDULE III THEREIN IN ORDER TO RESTRICT TRAFFIC ON SCOTT STREET TO ONE-WAY, IN THE DIRECTION FROM CHURCH STREET TO HIGH STREET. Council member Matt Brown motioned to approve Ordinance 2023-02. Terri Courtney seconded the motion. 3. **MUNICIPAL ORDER NO. 2023-02** A MUNICIPAL ORDER REAPPOINTING AND APPROVING ROSE BEACH TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF WALTON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, INC. FOR A NEW FOUR (4) YEAR TERM TO EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2026. Council member Matt Brown motioned to approve Municipal Order 2023-01. Terri Courtney seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following council members voted “yes”: Rose Beach, Matt Brown, Terri Courtney, Amy Long, Dan Martin and Sherry Snowden.
  
4. **RESOLUTION 2023-03** A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, OPPOSING THE PASSAGE OF SENATE BILL 50 AND HOUSE BILL 50 RELATING TO PARTISON LOCAL ELECTIONS. Council member Amy Long motioned to approve Resolution 2023-01. Terri Courtney seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following council members voted “yes”: Rose Beach, Matt Brown, Terri Courtney, Amy Long, Dan Martin and Sherry Snowden.
