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1. **ORDINANCE 2023-11 Second Reading** AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING SECTION 50.41(E) OF THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN ORDER TO REVISE THE PROCEDURES FOR WATER AND SEWER BILLING. Council member Dan Martin motioned to approve Ordinance 2023-11. Amy Long seconded the motion. Upon Roll call the following council members voted “yes”: Rose Beach, Amy Long, Dan Martin and Terri Courtney.

2. **ORDINANCE 2023-12 Second Reading** AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING SECTION 92.03 OF THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN ORDER TO REVISE THE PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO THE ADOPTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE. Council member Terri Courtney motioned to approve Ordinance 2023-12. Dan Martin seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following council members voted “yes”: Rose Beach, Amy Long, Dan Martin, and Terri Courtney.

3. **ORDINANCE 2023-13 First Reading** AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING CHAPTER 92 OF THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPOSITING OF LEAVES, GRASS CLIPPINGS AND OTHER YARD WASTE ONTO SIDEWALKS, STREETS, AND STORM SEWERS IS PROHIBITED AS A PUBLIC NUISANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR CIVIL FINES FOR PUBLIC NUISANCES. Council member Amy Long motioned to approve Ordinance 2023-13. Rose Beach seconded the motion. Upon roll call the following council members voted “yes”: Rose Beach, Amy Long, Dan Martin, and Terri Courtney.
