Second Reading – Ordinance 2025-18 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING SECTION 72.01 OF THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED LIMITATIONS ON STOPPING AND PARKING, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE THAT THE MAYOR, IN ADDITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL, MAY DESIGNATE A LIMITED OR NO PARKING AREA, AND CAUSE TO BE ERECTED SIGNS OR CURBS PAINTED IDENTIFYING SUCH PARKING AREAS.

Second Reading – Ordinance 2025-19 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING SECTION 92.16 OF THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED RUBBISH, IN ORDER TO EXPAND THAT TITLE TO INCLUDE EXCESSIVE GROWTH OF WEEDS AND GRASS, AND TO PROVIDE THAT A CITY REPRESENTATIVE MAY GIVE NOTICE OF VIOLATIONS AND TO ALLOW THE CITY TO REMEDY THE SITUATION IF THE OWNER OR AGENT OF THE PROPERTY FAILS TO DO SO, TO CHARGE THE OWNER FOR THE WORK, AND TO FILE A LIEN IF NOT PAID.
