

CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 2025-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, AMENDING SECTION 72.01 OF THE CITY OF WALTON CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED *LIMITATIONS ON STOPPING AND PARKING*, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE THAT THE MAYOR, IN ADDITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL, MAY DESIGNATE A LIMITED OR NO PARKING AREA, AND CAUSE TO BE ERECTED SIGNS OR CURBS PAINTED IDENTIFYING SUCH PARKING AREAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE

Section 72.01 of the City of Walton Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

§ 72.01 LIMITATIONS ON STOPPING AND PARKING.

- (A) It shall be unlawful to stop or park any motor vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directives of a police officer or traffic control device, in the following places:
 - (1) On or over a sidewalk;
 - (2) In front of a public or private driveway or within five (5) feet thereof;
 - (3) Within twenty-five (25) feet of any intersection, or across any intersection;
- (4) In a fire lane as determined by fire hydrant location or signage or within ten (10) feet of a fire hydrant;
- (5) In any area designated by the <u>MAYOR OR</u> City Council of the City of Walton, Kentucky, as a limited or no parking area, wherein the city <u>MAYOR OR</u> City Council has caused to be erected signs or curbs painted identifying such parking areas;
 - (6) In or around any cul-de-sacs.
- (B) All motor vehicles must be parked in the direction of traffic flow for the lane in which parked.

SECTION TWO

This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force upon adoption and publication according to law.

SECTION THREE

All ordinances or parts of any ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of the conflict, if any, are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular situation is, for any reason, found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions hereof, and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of that provision determined to be invalid.

SECTION FIVE

This ordinance may be read and published in summary form.
