Properly Discard Fats, Oils & Grease (FOG)

To help protect our pipes and keep community costs low, we encourage all customers to properly dispose of fats, oils, and grease:

*Don't pour oil, grease, or food scraps down the drain.

Instead, place them in the trash or in a covered collection container.

*Don't run hot water over greasy dishes, pans, or fryers.

Wipe grease off with a paper towel before washing by hand or in the dishwasher.

*Don't rely on a garbage disposal.

Use a sink strainer to catch excess food particles.

*Don't use chemicals to clear grease clogs.

These products can damage the piping system.

Proper FOG disposal helps prevent backups, reduces maintenance costs, and keeps our wastewater system running smoothly. Thank you for doing your part!

Snow Reminder

CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY
 ORDINANCE NO. 2025-04

(D) During snow emergencies, where snowfall is PREDICTED TO ACCUMULATE TO 2" or greater, motor vehicles shall not be parked or abandoned on streets or roadways, so as to impede the removal of snow or ice.
