- **For safety purposes, parade floats and vehicles transporting children or other passengers are prohibited from stopping, parking, or unloading on or near railroad tracks. Parade floats and vehicles are required to unload all passengers at the school parking lot designated by event officials.**
- Candy is permitted to be thrown during the OFD parade. You must make sure all candy clears the vehicle/floats.
- Each unit must have an entry form. It is the contact's responsibility to make sure all parade participants adhere to parade rules.
- Parade order is up to the sole discretion of the parade organizers.
- It is the responsibility of each entry to maintain a reasonable pace to eliminate gaps in the flow of the parade. Volunteer parade marshals will be stationed along the parade route to keep the parade moving.
- If the parade is stopped for any reason, please make sure that your float and or vehicle is clear of the railroad tracks. As the train does not stop and could come through at any time.
- Any parade entry with children under the age of 18 must always have adult supervision on the float/entry. Adult supervision must be someone other than the driver.
- Parade marshals are volunteers. All entries must follow their direction during the parade.
- All entrants must carry adequate insurance coverage and be driven by a competent, licensed driver. The parade contact is responsible for informing drivers of the line-up locations, and pick-up area.
- Festival organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- Entries with animals must have a clean-up crew following them.
- No parade entry can exceed 11 feet in height (measured from ground level).
