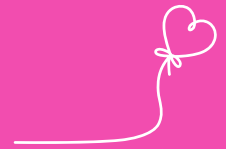

4th Monday of each month.**

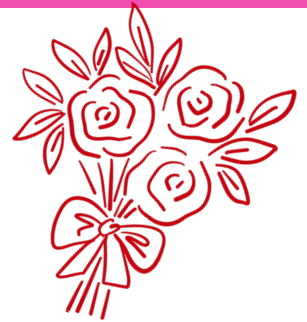
Be Concerned is deeply committed to honoring the dignity and humanity of all persons.
